PMAC Flood Committee
Monthly Report

Oct. 13, 2005

1. Sandbag wall at Butano Bridge--Oct. 29th and 30th are the two days for the rebuild and raise project. 20-30 inmates will, with supervision, be joining us. Cover cloth has been purchased.
Sandbags are being located via county--either filled bags or the sandbag machine and lots of empty bags. Bill Cook is hosting a block party all weekend to get the job done.
Trucks & trailers along with hands (and shovels) are more than welcome.
2. FEMA assistance with home raising--Former FEMA Director Mike Brown, a.k.a. "Brownie", will be leading this effort. He recommending **lowering** all homes in Pescadero 6' below FEMA designated flood levels. This will permit easier access by rescue boats.

In all seriousness, now is not the time to approach FEMA about this issue. There is still no District IX representative and all focus is being placed on the end of hurricane season and rebuilding after this years' hurricane damage.

3. There is a pending permit request (State Parks) to do some levee removal in the Marsh. This is also a flood control issue and should continue to be supported by PMAC as the levee removal will add floodwater storage capacity to the Marsh rather than use the streets of downtown Pescadero.

Emergency Committee Supplement:

1. Two repeater sites have been identified and visited. One up on Alpine road, located on private property, and a second site on Towne Ridge in San MacDonald County Park (sharing space with County radio equipment). Site testing will be completed shortly and a selection made. For many reasons, it is recommended that PMAC should support the County site rather than deal with the potential issues of dealing with a private landowner.
2. Most all equipment is on hand and operational. ~\$150 worth of cabling and other electrical equipment will be purchased by Roy and donated to the project.
