1. Call to order/Roll Call: Meeting called to order at 7:30pm by Chair Catherine Peery.

2. Public Comments not on the agenda: Herb Hamor showed concern regarding the sequence and efficiency of the local fire departments' back-up system. OES does have an order in place, but is it adequate?

3. Announcements/Presentations:

A. RR motioned for GA to be Vice Chair of PMAC. DM second, all ayes.

B. Dave Clark, County Roads Director, presented his chip-seal plan for about 20 miles of local roads. They plan on mailing to all Pescadero residents and have information on the county website. They plan to begin work the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of July.

Herb Hamor noted that chip-seal is most effective on a sound road, and the roads on the list for improvement don't get much traffic at all. GA suggested a forum to discuss roads that should be given priority for the chip-seal trial. Perhaps we can use the June PMAC meeting for this purpose.

C. Greg Tim, Pescadero Historical Society, presented the idea of Pescadero becoming a historical district. He called it a casual list designating downtown buildings.

RR motioned (GA second) to write a letter to the Historical Resources Advisory Board with our input - reminding them that the community has not asked for this.

D. Matt Jacobs, Rich Gordon's office, presented the Agricultural Awareness Ordinance, noting that farming has been and will continue to be part of this community, and that neighbors must expect all the comes with agriculture - including farming and livestock. County is still looking for feedback from the Agricultural Advisory Board and PMAC.
