Subject: San Mateo County Chip Seal Project

The San Mateo County Board of Supervisors authorized County improvements in February 2008, which included the chip sealing of the following roads:

Alpine Road (Pescadero Creek Road to Portola State Park Road); Bean Hollow Road;
Gazos Creek Road (from Highway 1 to Cloverdale Road); Lobitos Creek Cut-off;
Lobitos Creek Road; Tunitas Creek Road (from Highway 1 to Lobitos Creek Road);
Pescadero Creek Road (from Bean Hollow Road to Stage Road); Pigeon Point Road; Wurr Road

This type of work is integral to the overall maintenance of County roads.

The work, which is currently scheduled to begin in mid July and to extend into early August of 2008, will result in some traffic delays and in periodic road closures not lasting more than 1 work day at any specific location. Where temporary road closures are necessary, detour routes will be signed. In addition, advisory signs notifying drivers of specific construction dates will be posted as construction schedules are finalized.
