SUBJECT: Improvement of an Informal Parking Area on Pescadero Creek Road near Stage Road - Pescadero Area

We will be grading, rocking and installing curb stops to improve an informal parking area on Pescadero Creek Road near its intersection with Stage Road, which is adjacent to the Pescadero business district. The community of Pescadero is defined as a Rural Service Center in the County's Local Coastal Plan, and as such, it provides services to the surrounding agricultural area and also provides services for people visiting, traveling or recreating on the south coast.

The parking area improvements were requested by the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council through the office of Supervisor Richard Gordon, as currently there is insufficient parking on Stage Road to meet the needs of the community. We also believe that it is important to keep the shoulders clear on Pescadero Creek Road since recreational bicyclists also frequent the area.

The work is estimated to cost \$17,500 and will be financed with 1/2 Cent Transportation Funds. There is no impact to the General Fund.

A Coastal Permit exemption has also been received for this work.
